

Pollinator Seed Mix Spring Seeding Tips



- Aim to seed prior to **May 1st**. Sites that can be irrigated (including hand watered) may be seeded prior to **June 1st**.
- Bulk up the seed mix with material such as coarse sand, vermiculite, sawdust, etc. to assist with visual reference for the area seeded.
- Hand disperse the seed evenly across the plot
- Immediately after seeding lightly rake or harrow the site to incorporate the seed into the upper ¼" of the soil
- If possible, apply light, frequent irrigations to the site for the first 2 months following seeding

Pollinator Seed Mix Fall Seeding Tips



- To allow for a dormant seeding, seed after the first, killing frost and before the first, considerable snow. The week before Thanksgiving is the sweet spot, but this is subject to change depending on the year.
- Bulk up the seed mix with material such as coarse sand, vermiculite, sawdust, etc. to assist with visual reference
- Hand disperse the seed evenly across the plot
- Immediately after seeding lightly rake or harrow the site to incorporate the seed into the upper ¼" of the soil

Wait to irrigate until the following spring
